

SOUTHERN SOCIETY FOR IRISH RED AND WHITE SETTERS
JUDGING LIST CRITERIA
(January 2011)

Applications should be made to the Club Secretary. The list is valid for one year and inclusion on the list in one year does not necessarily ensure inclusion in subsequent years. Inclusion on the list is subject to approval by a majority of the Judges Sub-Committee of The Southern Society for Irish Red and White Setters (SSIRWS).

A1 List

For persons who have previously been approved by the Kennel Club to award CCs in the breed, have completed their first appointment and have the support of the SSIRWS. (KC Policy)

A2 List

For persons who fulfil all the requirements for the A3 list and who have been assessed in accordance with Kennel Club requirements and accepted by the Kennel Club for inclusion on an A2 list and have the support of the SSIRWS. (KC Policy)

A3 List (Breed Specialist)

- Minimum of 7 years judging experience in this breed and have the support of the SSIRWS. (KC Policy)
- To have judged a minimum of 50 classes of this breed with an adequate geographical spread.
- To have judged (hands-on) a minimum of 100 dogs of this breed.
- To have attended a seminar given by a KC Accredited Trainer and passed the relevant examination on KC Regulations and Judging Procedures. (KC Policy)
- To have attended a seminar given by a KC Accredited Trainer on Conformation and Movement. (KC Policy)
- To Have Attended a Conformation and Movement “Hands-on Assessment” conducted by a KC Accredited Trainer and passed the assessment. (KC Policy)
- To have attended at least one Breed Specific Seminar run in accordance with the relevant KC Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable. (KC Policy)
- To have bred and/or owned a minimum of 3 dogs when they have obtained their entry in the Kennel
- To have stewarded at 12 shows. (KC Policy)

A3 List (Non Specialist)

- Minimum of 7 years judging experience in any one breed (to include 5 years in this breed) and have the support of the SSIRWS. (KC Policy)
- To have judged a minimum of 36 classes of this breed with an adequate geographical spread.
- To have judged (hands-on) a minimum of 100 dogs of this breed.
- To have awarded CCs in at least one other breed. (KC Policy)
- To have attended at least one Breed Specific Seminar run in accordance with the relevant KC Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable. (KC Policy)

B List (Breed Specialist)

- To have 5 years experience owning and exhibiting in this breed and have the support of the SSIRWS.
- To have judged 9 classes of this breed at Open Shows or Championship Shows without CCs with an adequate geographical spread.
- To have judged (hands-on) 27 dogs of this breed
- To have attended at least one Breed Specific Seminar run in accordance with the relevant KC Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable. (KC Policy)

B List (Non Specialist)

- Minimum of 7 years judging in any one breed and have the support of the SSIRWS.
- To have judged 9 classes of this breed at Open Shows or Championship Shows without CCs with an adequate geographical spread and to have reasonable experience of judging other Gundog breeds.
- To have judged (hands-on) 27 dogs of this breed
- To have attended at least one Breed Specific Seminar run in accordance with the relevant KC Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable. (KC Policy)

C List (Specialist and Non Specialist)

- For Aspirant Judges who have shown an interest in the breed and have the support of the SSIRWS. (KC Policy)
